In attendance was Robert Summerville, Assistant Director of the Traffic and Transportation Department for the City of Charleston. His discussion centered on being proactive...tackle the problems with traffic, congestion and speeding before it gets out of hand. We discussed traffic lights, speed humps and zebra crossings. Special emphasis was placed on the danger of crossing Calhoun and Meeting streets. Mr. Summerville said an outside consultant is now studying the problem of synchronizing signal lights downtown.

Councilman Robert Mitchell spoke of getting young people back into recreation and the parks. Communities must stick together he said. Mr. Mitchell regularly attends the Neighborhood meetings.
